

2017 Third International Workshop on Guanxi for Guanxi Studies

“关系”研究论坛（英文名为“Guanxi for Guanxi Study Conference”），论坛时间为2017年5月30日，历时一天，由清华大学社会网络研究中心主办。事前，在第十二届“中国社会学会社会网与社会资本专业委员会”年会上，选择最优秀的论文，经过清华大学社会网络研究中心主任罗家德老师向全国年轻社会网络研究教师征得优秀论文，得到10篇，在工作坊一天中，以Ron. Burt教授、林南教授为主要评议人，为十名国内优秀学者（杨张博、林蓉蓉、帅满、韩亦、王颂、宋继文、刁鹏飞、戎珂、曹潇云、任婕，排名按照展示顺序）及其合作者的现有研究提供建议。各位作者论文在会议行发表后，可以现场得到两位指导老师对理论及模型上的建议，学者根据所得到的指导进行回应，修改模型，探讨理论，从而达到为学者提供学术提升的效果。
